Policy Statement

This Cookie Policy explains how we use cookies and similar tracking technologies across our websites. It applies to all users who visit our websites and sets out your rights and choices in relation to cookies.

Our websites use cookies to enhance user experience, analyse traffic, and deliver relevant content. This policy complies with the UK General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR) and the Privacy and Electronic Communications Regulations (PECR).

What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your device by websites you visit. They are widely used to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to website owners.

Cookies can be;

- Session cookies: These are deleted automatically when you close your browser.
- Persistent cookies: these remain on your device until they expire or are deleted.
- First-party cookies: These ones are set by the website you are visiting.
- Third-party cookies: Set by other websites or services embedded in the site you visit.

What Cookies We Use

1. Strictly Necessary Cookies

These cookies are essential for the website to function and cannot be switched off. They are usually only set in response to actions made by you, such as filling in forms or booking a session.

2. Performance and Analytics Cookies

These cookies help us understand how visitors interact with our website by collecting and reporting information anonymously. For example, we may use Google Analytics or similar tools to monitor site traffic and usage.

3. Functionality Cookies

These cookies enable enhanced functionality and personalisation, such as remembering your preferences or login status.

4. Third-Party Cookies

We may use cookies from third-party services such as:

- Google Fonts (to display website typography)
- Email newsletter providers (if you sign up for updates)

Third-party cookies are controlled by the respective providers and governed by their privacy policies.

Your Cookie Choices

When you first visit our websites, you will be presented with a cookie message giving you the option to accept or reject non-essential cookies. You can also manage your cookie preferences at any time through your browser settings.
